21 March 2014 afternoon – Everbright’s volunteer team visited Pok Oi Hospital Mrs Lee Ho Siu Fong Memorial Children and Families Development Centre located in Tuen Mun. This centre provides services mainly to the children from grassroots families which cannot afford to pay for leisure activities and tuition classes. Through visiting the centre, the volunteers showed their care and love to the children and taught them simple English vocabularies through activities. It was full of fun and laughter on the day, both the volunteers and children enjoyed themselves very much. Everbright CEO Chen Shuang’s wife and daughter also joined the volunteer work this time, we truly thank for their support and participation.
